



PROVISIONAL RULES FOR THE CAPE CUTTER 19 ASSOCIATION

1 TITLE

The full title of the Association shall be the Cape Cutter 19 Association.

2 OBJECTS

The objects of the Association are to promote and further the interests of the members of the Cape Cutter 19 Association throughout the world to help any owner of a Cape Cutter 19, or any other similar design by Dudley Dix whether built of wood or fiberglass to get more enjoyment from his or her boat. To help this the Association will:

- a. Publish information on the Cape Cutter 19 Association web site. The Cape Cutter 19 Association forum will be at the heart of communication within the Association.
- b. Encourage the dissemination of information on the Cape Cutter 19, seamanship, and sailing of the Cape Cutter 19.
- c. To encourage the holding of rallies of the Cape Cutter 19, and other similar boat designed by Dudley Dix and social events for members. So long as skippers are members of the Cape Cutter 19 Association other makes of boats are welcome.
- d. To keep a Members' Register.

3 MEMBERSHIP

- a. Membership shall, upon payment of the prescribed subscription, be open to any person who owns, sails in, or is in any other way interested in the Cape Cutter 19 or any other similar design by Dudley Dix. Anyone is welcome to join the Association who supports and upholds the objects of the Association.

Categories of membership are as follows:

1. Member- being an individual person of 18 years or more.
 2. Temporary Member- being a person who is participating in a specific Association event and who is included on a Members rally application form (available to download from the Members area of the forum), or whose name is otherwise notified to the Association or Rally organizer in advance of that Association event or rally.
- b. No corporate membership is available.
 - c. Only persons who have paid their subscription and are therefore deemed to be members of the Association shall be entitled to discuss Association business conducted in the members area of the forum.

4 Management

- a. The Association will be managed through the Cape Cutter 19 Association forum, under the members section. All communication will be web based. This is to save any environmental cost of running the Association.
- b. Members access to the members section of the forum will only occur once the subscription cost has been paid. At this point the registered forum member will become an "Association Member".



5 Indemnity and Insurance

- a. Each member in respect of him or herself and any passenger or passengers or guests or guests of the member, shall be solely liable and bound to make good and relieve the Association from any liability, loss, claim or proceedings whatsoever arising under any statute or at common law in respect of personal injury to or death of any person whomsoever (whether a member or not) or in respect of any injury or damage whatsoever to any property real or personal (whether belonging to a member or any other party) and arising in any case out of or in the course of any rally or event arranged by the Association or in which the Association takes part unless due to any act or neglect of the Association or Committee and the member shall indemnify the Association against the same and against all actions costs and expenses whatsoever incurred by reason or on account thereof.

- b. It is a requirement of the Association that all craft taking part in rallies and events organised or supported by the Association are covered by suitable third party and passenger insurance for a minimum sum of £3,000,000 or such greater sum as may be set from time to time in accordance with rule 9c (6). Members attending such rallies and events shall certify on their rally application form that they hold such insurance.
